

My 1st back surgery was 7/21/15 and the second was 3/22/16. Dr. Reames was very explicit as to what he needed to do during the surgery. And, he was hoping to do just one surgery. However, that was not the case. I came thru the first surgery very well, but still had pain that spinal injections did not help. When it was decided that I did need the second surgery, he again explained in detail what he would be doing and the expected outcome. I had no questions!

It has been 8 months since my last surgery and I feel fantastic! I have no back pain and take no medication for my back even tho I have a great deal of arthritis in my back. I occasionally will have what I call "tired back" when I stand for long periods of time or sit in the same position with out moving. I still take no pain medication. Also, my 13 year old dog likes to run for short distances and I can keep up with him!

When I knew that I needed surgery, I was concerned. However, Dr.Reames came highly recommended by my primary doctor. And, after talking with him, I was very comfortable. I worked in a dialysis unit for 32+ years and worked with numerous doctors and surgeons. Dr. Reams is an excellent surgeon and definitely knows what he is doing!
